DIB-V

Intravaginal Device containing 1 gram progesterone per device

Net Contents
10 Intravaginal Devices
Each insert contains 1 gram progesterone



DIB-V is an intravaginal progesterone release insert for controlled breeding in cattle.

INDICATIONS:

- Treatment of post-partum anoestrus (non-cycling) cows
- Control of the oestrous cycle in maiden heifers and cows
- To enable synchronisation for:
 - concentrated artificial insemination (AI)
 - embryo collection and transfer programmes

DOSE:

One DIB-V insert per animal.

TREATMENT PROGRAMS

DIB-V is recommended for use in conjunction with GnRH (Gonadotropin Releasing Hormone) and Prostaglandin.

DIB-Synch program

This program* is suitable for treating non cycling heifers and cows (beef or dairy);

DAY 0	DAY 7	DAY 9	DAY 10
Insert DIB-V device, Inject GnRH	Remove device, Inject PG	Inject GnRH	FTAI 16 to 20 hours after 2nd GnRH injection

GnRH (Gonadotrophin Releasing Hormone) = 100ug gonadorelin
PG(prostaglandin) = 500ug cloprostenol
FTAI= fixed time artificial insemination

The DIB-Synch program is also suitable for cycling cows as an oestrus synchrony program*

*Reproductive treatment and oestrus synchrony programs may be modified according to veterinary advice.

Formula

Each device contains 1 gram Progesterone in an inert silicone elastomer.

Presentation

Bag containing 10 intravaginal devices with tails

Store at room temperature, out of reach of children

Contraindications:

Not suitable for use in animals with abnormal vaginas. Animals in poor condition resulting from illness or nutritional stress may not respond

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

By law the user must take due care, obtaining expert advice when necessary, to avoid unnecessary pain and distress when using the product other than as directed on the label.

1. Wear rubber gloves when handling inserts
2. Wash the applicator in a non-irritating antiseptic solution and dip the front portion in veterinary obstetrical lubricant to assist ease of insertion
3. Place the insert into the applicator so that the wings are folded and the tips are protruding from the front of the applicator
4. Dip the front of the applicator into veterinary obstetrical lubricant
5. Lift the cow's tail and wipe the vulva clean
6. With tail lifted insert the loaded device, sloping it slightly upwards, through the vulva and then forward, into the forward portion of the vagina. NB Do not insert into overly small animals when application discomfort is evident.
7. Release the device from the applicator and then remove the applicator
8. Approx 10cm of the tail of the device should be visibly protruding from the vulva

Removal:

Remove by gently, but firmly, pulling on the protruding tail of the device

Disposal:

Used inserts and packaging should be burnt in an appropriate incinerator, buried in an approved landfill, or disposed of by approved methods.

Withholding Period:

Meat: nil
Milk: nil
Remove inserts before slaughter
